### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I congratulate our Management Committees throughout the country that continue to provide opportunities for fellowship during the fourth Wave of the Covid -19 Pandemic. Some Clubs were able to hold their meetings outdoors and some Clubs have begun to hold Hybrid Meetings. I would like to briefly describe the origin of our Zoom Support Program.

The PROBUS CANADA Zoom Support Program was the brainchild of **Dan Clements** of the Cambridge Men's Club. Dan and **Rad Bazzul** the then

President of the Cambridge Men's Club, had put together a Zoom workshop on Zooming through the Covid-19 in early June 2020. Just under 70 PROBUS Members from across Canada attended that first workshop and the recording of that meeting has since had over 700 views and the help it offers is still useful today over a year later.

Recognising the interest throughout Canada in using Zoom to keep Probus members engaged Dan developed a proposal to offer Zoom support to all interested clubs across Canada. **Martin Capper** took Dan's proposal to the Board in August and got unanimous support for it.

Recognising that the demand was far greater than he alone could serve, Dan started to source and select extremely competent and personable Probus members to form a nucleus of mentors. Where possible mentors operated in their own Districts but many of the mentors assisted Clubs outside their own District.

This team of Mentors was given a head start in that they had available to them a significant number of documents, largely authored by Dan himself, on various procedures for running a Zoom Meeting. # CANADIAN ANTI-FRAUD CENTRE BULLETIN

COVID-19 Phishing Text Message Alert

2021-07-19

FRAUD: RECOGNIZE, REJECT, REPORT

Unfortunately, scammers continue to exploit the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre has received reports of phishing text message scams tied to COVID-19 vaccines. The text messages claim to be from the Government of Canada and will say that due to a recent vaccination, Canadians are eligible for a Vaccine Relief Fund. The message then tells you to claim your funds by clicking on a link.

Phishing messages will ask you to click on a link for various reasons. The goal is to steal your personal and/or financial information, which can be used for identity fraud.

Don't click the link and don't provide any personal information!

# Warning Signs and How to Protect Yourself

- Beware of unsolicited text messages and emails from individuals or organizations asking you to click on a link or attachment
- Watch for spelling mistakes in unsolicited messages
- Verify the hyperlink behind the link's text or button by hovering over the text with your mouse
- Do not click on links or attachments in unsolicited messages; they can contain viruses or spyware
- The Government of Canada will never send funds by email or text message
- Learn more tips and tricks for protecting yourself from fraud.


#### PROBUS LAPEL PINS

Regular PROBUS lapel pins are \$5.50 each in orders of less than 25 but only \$4.50 each in orders of 25 or more.


